I have often said with regard to flowable resins that I wanted a flowable that was not a "runnable." Shofu has created just such a product with its new, non-flow, sculptable, Beautifil® Flow Plus composite resin. This is a great material as a final restoration for minimally invasive procedures in both the posterior and anterior dentition. You do not need to place another layer of composite resin on top. I am quite pleased with how well this material handles, especially when restoring root caries and the more conventional Class V lesions (whether caused by decay or abrasion). The material stays where it is placed and is available in two formulations: a non-flow sculptable (F00) or a low-flow (F03). There are nine shades for F00, including opaque, incisal, and bleach white, and 12 shades for F03, including a unique A0.5, milky, and cervical shades. I am quite impressed by the great diverse quality of these resins. This material also is useful in creating

cusp height and marginal ridges. Beautifil Flow Plus contains the proprietary GIOMER chemistry and S-PRG fillers, which release and recharge fluoride like a glass ionomer. Both formulations will polish to a very high gloss, which is expected from the people who produce the highly acclaimed One Gloss and Super Snap Single polishing systems. This is a very useful resin product that allows us to truly emphasize the artistic element of the "art and science" of dentistry.



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
