You asked for it — now you have it! Shofu has launched Beautifil II LS (Low Shrink). This latest addition to Shofu's Beautifil line of Giomer S-PRG products is a composite resin with low polymerization shrinkage, designed for both the anterior and posterior restorations. This novel LS monomer has achieved 30-40 percent reduction in polymerization shrinkage, especially when coupled with its new high functional prepolymerized S-PRG fillers and sub-micron multi-functional glass fillers. In addition, this great new composite has a longer working time, which is often necessary for large and deep Class II restorations. Couple that with greater polishability, and you will

achieve esthetic result mimicking natural dentition's optical properties of light diffusion, fluorescence and transparency. The enamel shades provide the enamellike light transmission characteristics. while the opaque shades diffuse light like dentin. To make it even more userfriendly, the universal shades combine both characteristics with minimal color change after photo-curing. Like all the Beautifil composites, there is less occlusal wear, high compressive and flexural strength and a high degree of radiopacity. What impresses me most is the research showing the suppression of the contraction gap due to the low polymerization shrinkage, and that translates to long-term restoration and a healthier outcome for the patient.
